Scholarships

Young Women in Public Affairs:

Scholarships to pre-college women committed to leadership in public policy, government and volunteer organizations.

Jane M. Klausman Women in Business:

Scholarships for women pursuing undergraduate degrees in business.

Community Service Grants

Grants awarded to local non-profit organizations serving our community who support our mission and ideals.

International Projects

Projects include education, leadership and youth development; preventing violence against women and other service projects. *Amelia Earhart Fellowships* are awarded to women pursuing PhD degrees in aerospace related sciences.
